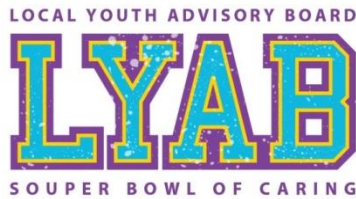


TACKLE HUNGER
